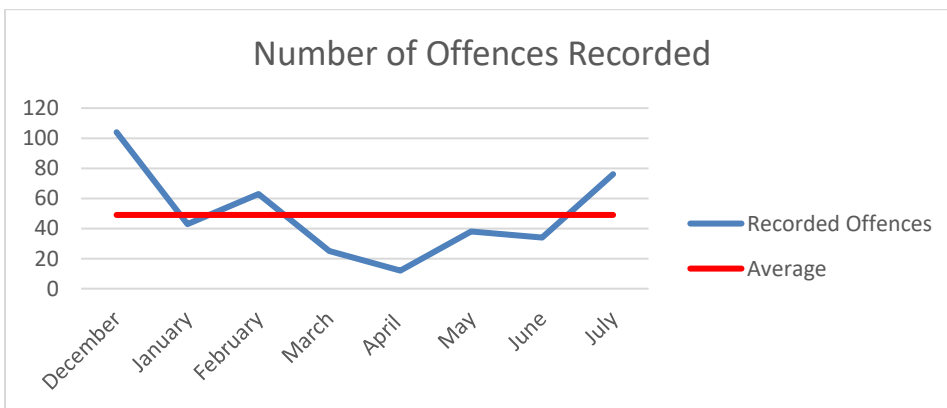
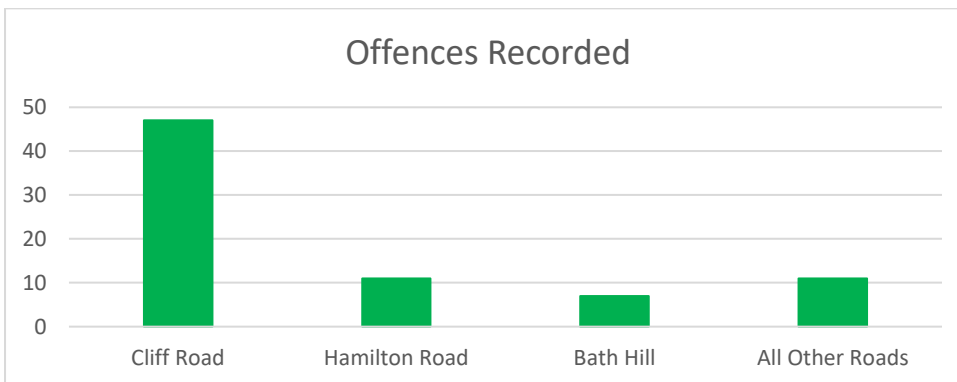




Felixstowe Partnership Funded PCSO Report for July 2019

SNT Agreed Priorities for July:	Actions and Outcomes
1. Parking – Cliff Road	Daily patrols and offences dealt with at the time. A positive reduction in vehicles parked on the verges during patrols however this increases during weekends.
2. Parking – Town Centre, Hamilton Road	Specific attention has been paid to priority 1 taking away from time available to patrol the town centre however enforcement is continuing.
3. ASB – Skate Park	The skatepark is being well used and I am making regular contact with the users and patrolling the area to deter ASB.

Total Parking Offences for July: 76



Particular attention has been paid to Cliff Road this month prior to the beginning of the school holidays. Over the course of several weeks and weekends over 45 offences were recorded and dealt with. This is a particular issue during the summer when the restriction is in place between May and September where vehicles park on the grass verge instead of using the nearby car parks which are available.

With the school holidays now approaching there is likely going to be a high influx of visitors to the beach areas of town. Attention should be paid to the areas that experience high traffic flow as often parking problems occur.
