



What we would call our core activity came to a complete stop during week commencing 16th March. All the clubs and social activities ceased to operate and our customers being the elderly and infirm had to self isolate. The bulk of our income immediately ceased.

Thanks to your grant and the generosity of the local community we have been able to continue functioning and have since 23rd March delivered food parcels for the Basic Life Charity and prescription medication for the Day Lewis Pharmacy at the Grove.

By close of play tomorrow we will have delivered around 400 parcels and in excess of 8000 items of medication.

Day Lewis have been so thankful for our services, by delivering medication to the over 70s and those with health conditions, we have not only made sure that these people received their medication promptly, we have also eased the burden on the pharmacy. We expect this to continue for the next few weeks.

We have also transported the vulnerable and infirm to their hospital appointments at both Ipswich Hospital and Felixstowe General.

We hope that we have and will continue to provide a vital and valuable service to the local community.

We are extremely grateful for all of the financial support we have received because there is no doubt that without it we would have had to cease operating.
